### **Drama Trip to Warwick Arts Centre**

As part of your daughter's Drama & Theatre Studies examination course I have arranged for her to see 'The Idiot Colony' at Warwick Arts Centre on Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> November 2009. Your daughter will then spend time disseminating the production in preparation for her written exam this January. The play concerns the plight of 3 women in an abandoned mental institution. The play has won numerous awards at this year's Edinburgh fringe festival for its design elements in particular. We are sure that your daughter will find the trip worthwhile and enlightening.

Details of the trip are as follows:

- We will leave school at 5.30 p.m. and travel by coach to Warwick.
- The performance starts at 7.45 p.m. and should finish before 10.00 p.m.
- We will make our way back to the coach for 10.00 p.m. and hope to arrive at school at approximately 11.00 p.m., although students will be asked to update parents if times alter.
- The cost of this trip has been fully subsidised by the Performing Arts Department.
- Girls will need to bring their own food, or sufficient funds for food, should it be required.

***Please ensure that your daughter is collected promptly from the school.***

We need to complete a risk assessment for this trip in line with current Health & Safety requirements. In view of this, the consent and behaviour forms must be returned before **Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> October**. Your daughter will not be able to come on the trip if this deadline is not met.
