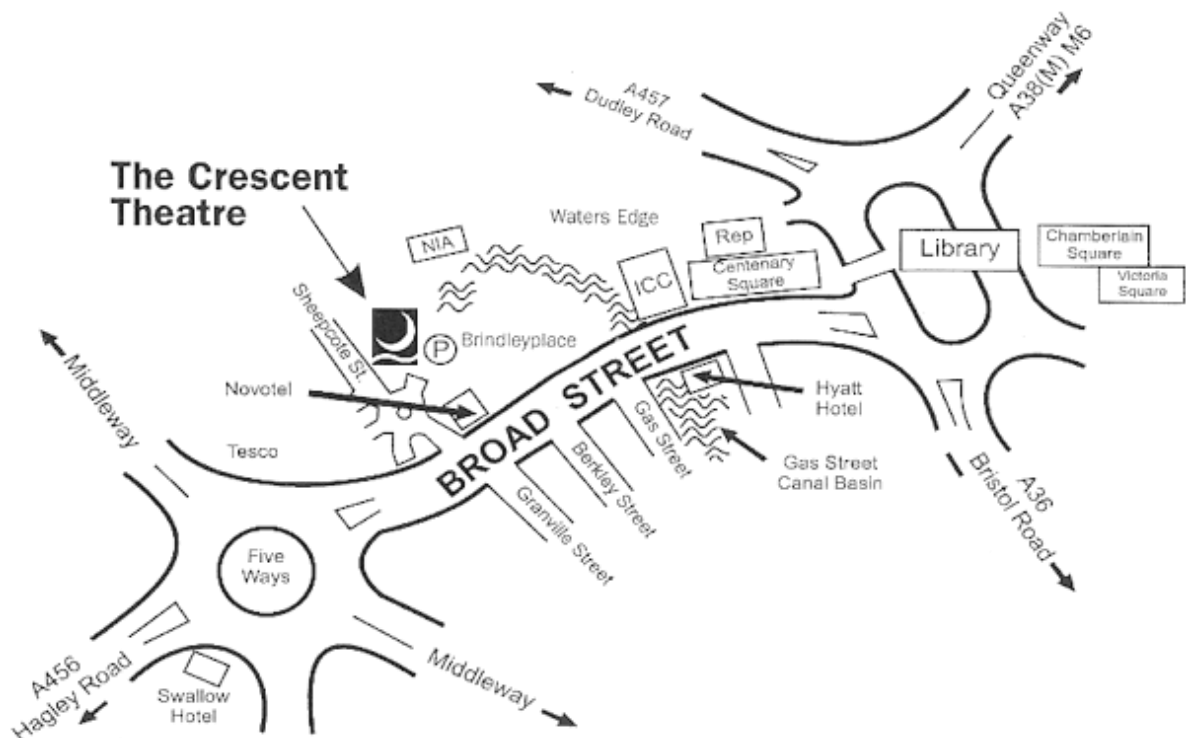

HOW TO FIND THE CRESCENT THEATRE



The Crescent Theatre is located just off Broad Street in the Brindleyplace development.

By car: Turn into Sheepcote Street at the traffic light junction by the Novotel, then follow the signposts for the Brindleyplace Car Park. The 903 space car park is situated next to the theatre and is safe, clean and well lit.

By public transport: New Street and Snow Hill stations are about 15 minutes walk away whilst Five Ways Station on the Cross City Line is just 10 minutes walk. Buses 1C, 9, 10, 21, 22, 23, 29, 103, 109, 120, 126, 139, 140 and 258 run along Broad Street. Taxis can drop passengers at the front entrance.
