Dear Parent(s)

This year, Induction Day for girls joining our Year 7 in September will take place on Wednesday 6th July. Your daughter will need to arrive here for the normal start of our school day at 8.30am and she may leave or be collected at 3.25 pm.

This will give your daughter the chance to have a trial run of the journey to school before she starts in September. Please note that she can use the school buses provided by the Green Bus Company to get to and from school. If you come by car, please come to Hall Road (B20 2BH) at the back of the school and drop your daughter at the gate. For safety reasons we request that you **do not** drive into the school car parks or playground. When she arrives in school, your daughter should report to the main Assembly Hall.

What happens on the day

Your daughter will be joining her class and during the day she will spend time with her form tutor and her buddy, and she will also sample some lessons.

What to bring on the day

Your daughter may wear her present school uniform or any other clothing you feel is suitable. Please make sure that she brings the following items with her on the day:-

- Writing materials – pen, pencil etc.
- A piece of work that your daughter is proud of.
- Money for any extra items e.g. drinks and desserts. Your daughter will be provided with a free lunch.
- Any outstanding forms from the Welcome Evening (including the Bockleton consent form if not ticked on ParentPay).
- Music lessons - if you have already requested an audition for your daughter please make sure she brings her instrument with her (if she already has one).

We hope that your daughter will enjoy the day and that it will help to make the transition from Primary to Secondary school a little easier. Please contact the school if you have any queries about these arrangements.

Important Information

During the Welcome Evening you will receive a letter informing you about ParentPay, with instructions and your password and username so that you can pay School Fund (£20), put money on your daughter's card if she is having school meals and pay for the Bockleton Residential and other trips.

For the beginning of the new term, Monday 5th September, your daughter will need two combination padlocks for her lockers. The padlocks must have a shank of between 5.5mm – 6.2mm.
