AGREEMENT

By the parents(s)* of a candidate accepted for admission to
KING EDWARD VI HANDSWORTH SCHOOL

IN CONSIDERATION of the admission of this child (hereinafter referred to as 'the pupil') to this King Edward VI Grammar School, I hereby undertake and agree with the Governors:

1. Not without the previous consent in writing of the Governors to withdraw the pupil from this School until the statutory school leaving date PROVIDED ALWAYS that such consent shall not be withheld in the event of:
 - a) The removal of the pupil's family from the district;
 - b) The prolonged illness of the pupil;
 - c) Any other good and sufficient cause proved to the satisfaction of the Governors.
2. That, although pupils are expected to remain until the age of 18 years, continuation beyond statutory school age will be reviewed by the School in the light of academic progress and general conduct.
3. To maintain the pupil in regular attendance at this School during the whole of each school term unless prevented from so doing on account of the pupil's illness (which shall be proved by the production of a medical certificate if required) or any other good and sufficient cause proved to the satisfaction of the Governors. I understand that attendance at the School or elsewhere is expected for sporting or other events if the pupil is selected to represent the School. Leave for family holidays during a school term is discouraged without good reason as it is detrimental to the pupil's education.
4. That the pupil shall conform to all the rules, regulations, and codes of conduct of this School for the time being in force. If the pupil shall fail to conform to all or any of the said rules, regulations and codes of conduct, the pupil will be subject to the School's disciplinary sanctions which may lead to temporary or permanent exclusion by the Head.
5. To reimburse the Governors for any damage to property wilfully or negligently caused by the pupil.
