

### **VISIT /TRIP /ACTIVITY RESPONSE**

- **I understand that once a commitment to go on a visit has been made, this must be honoured.**
- **I will ensure that my daughter is at the starting point on time and that she will be met at the stated time (unless the visit starts and/or ends during the school day).**
- **I note that she may not be under the direct supervision of staff at all times.**
- **I understand that school rules apply during the visit, that she will be subject to any local laws and that, in event of serious misbehaviour, I may be required to collect her or pay for her journey home in advance of the group.**
- **I note that staff cannot be responsible for my daughter's property and she should not bring valuables.**
- **I agree to her receiving emergency medical treatment, including blood transfusions and anaesthetics, as considered necessary by any medical authorities present in the event of illness. I understand that every effort will be made to contact me.**
- **I will ensure that my daughter brings with her any medication from home including inhalers and Epipen that she requires, and that any medical details held at the School are updated.**
- **We will ensure that all of our emergency contact details held at the School are correct.**

**I have read the information about the proposed Visit/ Activity and consent to my child participating. I declare that my child is fit enough to undertake the activity and I will notify the party Leader of any problems (Health related or otherwise) before the visit or activity commences. I authorize the Party Leader to act on my behalf in an emergency, including signing on my behalf any consent forms required by medical authorities should the Party Leader( or if the Party Leader is indisposed, any other responsible adult in the supervision of the trip) judge that after attempting to contact me , it would be inadvisable to delay matters while awaiting my own signature. I understand & accept that my child may be withdrawn from the trip if her behavior prior to the trip is unacceptable. This particularly applies to behavior which leads to concerns about trust and safety of other pupils.**
